Much consultation about locking the rooms resulted in finding keys a misfit and all doors kept unlocked except closet in Room 13 for supplies and desk. No rules formulated except that no books are to be taken from the building; smoking not allowed in the building; general conversation and other disturbance to orderly study not allowed, discussion or conversation incident to study permissible.
