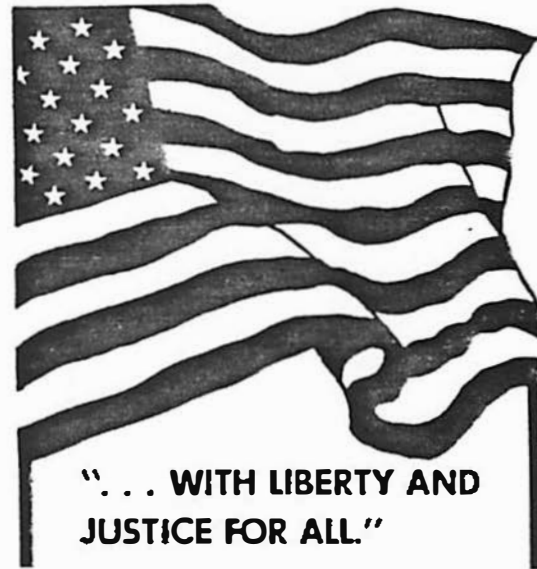
## *Faculty/Staff News*
