On January 19, 2012 the law firm of Weil, Gotshal & Manges sent you a letter on behalf of their client American Airlines disputing my earlier complaint filed with you on or about January 5 of 2012. In their counter letter they misrepresent the facts in my particular case. Unfortunately seriously misguide by their client American Airlines.

In April of 2011 American Airlines refunded the money of my Airline ticket that I now seek in mediation. I was stationed overseas and purchase my original ticket in Saudi Arabia from American's agent. 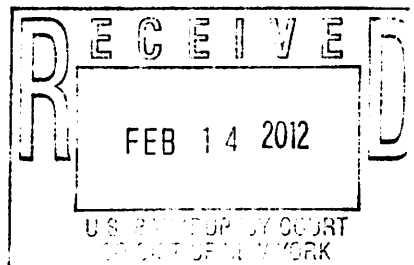
