A second disclosure statement and second plan of reorganization under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code having been filed by the debtor on December 13, 2011, it is ORDERED and NOTICE is given that:

2. January 17, 2012, is fixed as the last day for filing and serving written objections to the

Baker Jr. United States Courthouse, Suite 330, 800 Market Street, Knoxville, Tennessee. 4. Debtor's counsel shall immediately distribute the disclosure statement and plan in accordance with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3017(a) and shall serve this order and notice of hearing upon all parties in interest as required by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2002(b). A certificate of service to this effect shall be filed by debtor's counsel within three days from entry of this order.

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
