**FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER CONCERNING CREDITOR
TRUSTEE'S OMNIBUS PROTECTIVE OBJECTION TO CLAIMS**

Upon consideration of the *Creditor Trustee's Omnibus Protective Objection to Claims* (the "*Omnibus Protective Objection*");¹ the Court having reviewed the Omnibus Protective Objection and having heard the statements of counsel at a hearing (the "*Hearing*") before the Court on January 24, 2012; it appearing to the Court that: the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334, 28 U.S.C. § 157(a) and Northern District of Ohio General Order No. 84 filed and in effect as of July 16, 1984 and this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); the Court finding that due and adequate notice of the Omnibus Protective Objection and the Hearing were provided; and the Court being fully advised in the premises and

having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Omnibus Protective Objection and at the Hearing establish just cause for the relief granted herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

A. Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 102(1), 105(a) and 502(b), Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3007 and that certain *Order Approving Claims Reconciliation Procedure for Former Employees and Medical Providers Holding Healthcare Claims* (Docket No. 999) (the “*Healthcare Claims Order*”), each Claim listed on *Exhibit A* hereto is disallowed and expunged in its entirety.

B. The Creditor Trustee’s objection to Claim No. 626 filed by Lowell Perry is withdrawn without prejudice.

C. The Creditor Trustee’s objection to Claim No. 573 filed by Anes and P.C. of Akron has been resolved pursuant to the Healthcare Claims Order; accordingly, Claim No. 573 shall be allowed as a General Unsecured Claim in the amount of \$639.00.

D. The Creditor Trustee’s objection to Claim No. 412 filed by Gulf Coast Medical Center has been resolved pursuant to the Healthcare Claims Order; accordingly, Claim No. 412 shall be allowed as a General Unsecured Claim in the amount of \$44,341.84.

E. The Creditor Trustee’s objections to Claim Nos. 351, 352 and 353 filed by the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation shall be continued for hearing to March 27, 2012, at 2:00 p.m. (Eastern).

F. The Creditor Trustee’s objection to the scheduled claim of Wells Fargo TPA shall be continued for hearing to March 27, 2012, at 2:00 p.m. (Eastern).

G. The Creditor Trustee’s objections to Claim Nos. 313, 320, 322, 326, 327, 342, 571 and 607 filed by the Department of Treasury – Internal Revenue Service (“*IRS*”) shall be continued for hearing to March 27, 2012, at 2:00 p.m. (Eastern). The deadline for the IRS to respond to the Omnibus Protective Objection shall be continued indefinitely to permit continued

global settlement discussions between the Creditor Trustee and the IRS.

H. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over the Creditor Trustee and the Creditors whose Claims are subject to the Omnibus Protective Objection with respect to any matters related to or arising from the implementation of this Order.

I. This Order is without prejudice to the Creditor Trustee's right to object to any other Claims in these chapter 11 cases or to further object to the Claims objected to in the Omnibus Protective Objection.
