AGREED ORDER GRANTING 1) EMERGENCY MOTION OF DEBTOR AND DEBTOR-IN-POSSESSION TO ENFORCE THE AUTOMATIC STAY [DOCKET NO. 405] AND 2) EMERGENCY MOTION OF DEBTOR AND DEBTOR-IN-POSSESSION FOR AN ORDER COMPELLING TURNOVER OF BOOKS, RECORDS, AND BANK STATEMENTS OF FPMC SERVICES, LLC RELATING TO DEBTOR’S PROPERTY OR FINANCIAL AFFAIRS [DOCKET NO. 397]

Came on for consideration the *Emergency Motion of Debtor and Debtor-in-Possession to Enforce the Automatic Stay* [Docket No. 405] and the *Emergency Motion of Debtor and Debtor-in-Possession for an Order Compelling Turnover of Books, Records, and Bank Statements of FPMC Services, LLC Relating to Debtor’s Property or Financial Affairs* [Docket No. 397] (the “Motions”) filed by Forest Park Medical Center at Frisco, LLC, debtor and debtor-in-possession in the above referenced bankruptcy case (the “Debtor”). The Court, having considered the statements of counsel, finds that the parties have reached an agreement with respect to the Motions. It is therefore

ORDERED that the Motions are **GRANTED** on the terms and conditions as specifically stated herein. It is further

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ORDERED that FPMC Services, LLC agrees to continue to provide the Debtor with access to historical information necessary to complete 1) the Debtor's monthly or quarterly operating reports for the duration of the bankruptcy case as well as any other reporting as required by this Court or the U.S. Trustee's office, and 2) any due diligence information requests commensurate with the information provided by FPMC Services, LLC to the Debtor since the Petition Date. It is further

ORDERED that the Debtor will continue to pay its allocation of payroll and benefits for FPMC Services, LLC and will continue to reimburse FPMC Services, LLC for expenses actually paid by FPMC Services, LLC post-petition. It is further

ORDERED that FPMC Services, LLC reserves its rights to seek compensation from the Debtor in the form of an administrative expense claim or such other form of claim as is asserted by FPMC Services, LLC. It is further

ORDERED that the Debtor and FPMC Services, LLC agree to work together to present a form of proposed protective order or obtain such consents from other parties as necessary to enable FPMC Services, LLC to produce bank statements and other documents relating to the property or financial affairs of the Debtor as reasonably requested by the Debtor. It is further

ORDERED that the Debtor and FPMC Services, LLC agree to work together to reach a production schedule for FPMC Services, LLC's bank statements. It is further

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ORDERED that all other relief requested by the Motions is denied without prejudice. The Debtor acknowledges that FPMC Services, LLC disputes and does not agree with the allegations contained in the Motions.
