**ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION OF
CINCINNATI INDUSTRIAL AUCTIONEERS, INC.
FOR PAYMENT OF FEES AND EXPENSES
UNDER AUCTION CONTRACT APPROVED BY THE COURT**

Upon consideration of the application dated June 14, 2010 (the "Application") of auctioneer Cincinnati Industrial Auctioneers, Inc. ("CIA") for entry of an order approving and ordering payment of fees (commissions), and expenses under auction contract approved by the Court, and based upon the Cincinnati Report attached to the Application, and there being no objection filed to the Application, this Court finds that: (i) it has jurisdiction over the matters raised in the Application under 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; (ii) venue of this matter is proper under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; (iii) this matter is a core proceeding under 28 U.S.C. § 157(B)(2); (iv) relief requested in the

Application is in the best interests of Debtors, their estates, creditors, and other parties in interest; (v) adequate and proper notice of the application and notice to timely respond has been given and that no other or further notice is necessary; and (vi) good and sufficient cause exists for the granting of the relief requested in the Application as set forth herein. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED THAT:

1. The Application is GRANTED and APPROVED in its entirety.
2. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in the Application.
3. In accordance with section 327(a) and 328 of the Bankruptcy Code, and Rules 2014 and 6003(a) of the Bankruptcy Rules, LBR 6005-1(b), and the auction contract approved by this Court, Debtors shall be and hereby are authorized and directed to, and shall disburse to CIA, the sum of \$212,000.00 in payment of auction expenses, fees, and commissions due under the auction contract approved by Order entered April 16, 2010.
4. This compensation is in accordance with the terms set forth in the Application, the Order Approving Application of Debtors and Debtors in Possession, Pursuant to Sections 327(a) and 328 of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rule 2014(a) and 6003(a), for the Entry of an Order Authorizing Debtors to Retain and Employ Cincinnati Industrial Auctioneers, Inc. as Auctioneer for Non-Core Personal Property Assets Nunc Pro Tunc as of the Filing Date entered April 16, 2010, and the application of the Debtors requesting such Order filed April 5, 2010, and any applicable order of the Court.
5. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters emanating from this Order.

6. This Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon entry.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
